WHAT TO BRING

Each camper must provide his own equipment including cleats, helmet, mouthpiece, football pants, and shoulder pads. Coaches need to bring footballs and equipment kits.

Camp has two divisions, a Varsity group and a JV group. If you bring enough players to have two groups, we want to provide as many reps as possible during the scrimmages.

CAMP FEES

Cost: \$60 per player

Cost of camp includes a Concordia camp t-shirt.

Overnight campers add an additional \$20 per camper per night (*housing only*). Space is limited. On campus dining will be available for additional fee.

LATE REGISTRATION FEE
