

Concordia University, Nebraska accepts up to 70 hours of credit from a two-year college toward the completion of a four-year program of study. Only courses with a grade of C- or above will be accepted for transfer credit. A minimum of 120 hours must be completed with total hours required varying by major. Students must also complete 1) all CUNE General Education requirements and 2) a minimum of 30 hours at CUNE with a minimum of 12 hours completed at the 300 or 400 level.
